

Dear Friends,

I hope this finds you and your family well. It is hard to believe that we are almost to the end of 2022. But here we are, the week before Thanksgiving, as of the writing of this letter. Time goes so quickly. I began thinking about the value of time. I'm reminded of a poem on the subject (author unknown): "You have only just one minute. Only sixty seconds in it. Forced upon me --

- can't refuse it. But it is up to you to use it. You must suffer it or lose it. Give account if you abuse it." God has given a gift to each of us in the gift of time. All His gifts are conditional upon time. What you do with God's time is your gift back to Him. He uses both time and, yes, trouble, as tools to build His people. If we mess up the 1440 minutes (24 hours) given us today, we can change it tomorrow with a fresh start. We change our lives one day at a time.

And the amazing thing is that God never loads the weight of tomorrow on today. It makes no sense to kill time today worrying about tomorrow. I wonder for how many of you that today is the tomorrow you worried about yesterday? The gospels tell us we cannot add one bit of height to our stature by worrying about tomorrow.

But many who waste this precious gift of time do it to their own injury as well as God's. God warns us about the proper use of time because time waits for no man. "To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven..." (Eccles. 3:1) Youths tend to count time. But wise people make time count.

I began to think about all the time saving devices we have today... more than any other period in history. Yet, we do not have enough time! Seems to me like we need to reevaluate our time and what we spend it on.

How we spend this precious life, this gift of time here on earth matters. I am truly grateful for all you who make it a point to spend time here at Hope For The Future Ministries. We rely on the goodness of volunteers and the generosity of supporters to keep this ministry going. I am committed to seeing that The Kingdom's next generation will carry the torch of HFTF forward. With your continued, faithful support and care we will be able to do just that.
